3. Applications must be returned to the committee prior to March 1st.
4. In addition to the completed application and required documentation, those applying for aid must provide satisfactory proof of Irish ancestry.
5. You may submit up to two letters of recommendation.
6. Please request a transcript from either your high school or college records office, as appropriate. These should be sent directly to the committee.
7. Your application for this grant program does not in any way obligate the Hibernian Society to provide assistance.

Explanation of Program

1. Scholarship grants are given for one semester only. Subsequent grants are dependent upon the recipient's academic performance in prior semesters.
2. Grant funds may be used only for college level coursework at either a two or four year university.
3. In order to be eligible for future aid, recipients must maintain a C+ or better average or equivalent.
